

# ENCASE Architecture

# First study on how disinformation spreads among Web communities

- Looked into fringe web communities, such as 4chan/pol, reddit/The\_Donald, gab
- Innovative use of Hawkes processes to infer causal relationships between Web posts







Figure 29: A very comfy Savvas Zannettou
